

Registration Notes for Fall 2007 registration

- 1) Business Policy MGMT
 - a. Is not MGMT 499
 - b. You must have senior standing
 - c. You must get a permit to take the course from the deans office. No online registration.
 - d. If you are eligible to take this, you should have an email.
 - e. CIS NETSEC students are not required to take this course.
- 2) ECON 100
 - a. If you have this already you cannot take ECON 101 or ECON 102 for credit.
 - b. This course is a prereq for all other 200+ ECON classes.
 - c. CIS NETSEC if you have 100 this will count as your econ class. Otherwise take 101 or 102, your choice.
- 3) FNCE 301
 - a. Pre-reqs are strictly enforced
 - i. ACCT 101
 - ii. ACCT 102
 - iii. MATH 120/121 and MATH 122/124
- 4) FNCE 260
 - a. If you need this (it is no longer offered), take FNCE 301 and prereqs.
- 5) COOP Courses
 - a. These are all 469,
- 6) Freshmen in GSB (except NETSEC) should complete
 - a. Core 102
 - b. Core 104
 - c. Math 120 or 121 or 207
 - d. Math 122 or 124
 - e. WTNG 102
 - f. WTNG 220
 - g. BUSN 100
 - h. CIS 101 or 102
 - i. Econ 101
 - j. Econ 102
- 7) Freshmen in NETSEC should complete
 - a. Core 102
 - b. Core 104
 - c. Math 120 or 121
 - d. Math 122 or 124
 - e. Or other math (135/137 || 213/214)
 - f. BUSN 100

- g. Econ 101 or 102
 - h. CIS 200
 - i. WTNG 102
 - j. WTNG 220
 - k. Or review your program plan
- 8) MRKT Majors
- a. CIS 350 counts as a marketing elective
- 9) Non-Business electives
- a. CIS courses are now non-business electives
 - b. The first three econ courses are non-business electives. You can take one econ beyond 101 and 102 before it becomes a business elective.
- 10) Closed Courses
- a. The dean's office has waiting lists.
- 11) Pre-requisite waivers
- a. All waivers are done by the dean's office.
- 12) Core Concentrations
- a. Juniors and Seniors should have both their major and core concentration declared. Forms are in the dean's office. Sophomores should consider declaring a core concentration in the Spring.
 - b. Every RWU student must complete a core concentration
 - c. Minors are optional
 - d. Minors and CC can be in the same area.
 - e. CIS majors may do a core concentration in economics. Other bus majors may not.
 - f. Be sure that you can complete your CC in a reasonable time (prereqs etc.)
